

Diploma in Midwifery

During the pandemic period, students of the 5th batch of the Diploma in Midwifery Programme were sent to Cox's Bazar (PHD's delivery centres) Rohingya project in alternate groups. They went there in 3 groups; 2 of the groups were performing their CEGM and the other was fulfilling their graduation target. Moreover, they worked there for 24/7, under the supervision of DMP's senior midwives. According to the students, they did not face any challenges while working, except for the language barrier.
