We are looking to recruit several positions of Assistant Scientist/ Assistant Professor for the School.

Key responsibilities:

- To develop proposals for research projects which increase the knowledge, understanding, and discovery of new explanations, insights, concepts, and processes as Principal Investigator' or 'Co-Principal Investigator'
- To lead quantitative research activities and projects including the development of the personal, group, or collaborative objectives, as & Principal Investigator' or 'Co-Principal Investigator'
- To develop research protocols, interpret research findings, generate high-quality publications, and disseminate results through appropriate media
- To prepare reports and present information to research groups, steering groups, etc. particularly progress reports, overseeing similar activities of research assistants when appropriate
- To identify sources of funding and lead the process of application
- To manage research project budgets and other resources
- To lead and develop internal and external networks, and collaborative groups, representing the University in a professional manner at all times, including links with professional bodies, research funding streams etc.
- To mentor junior researchers' workshops and training on quantitative research methods
- To supervise MPH students for the summative learning project, if required to teach relevant courses in MPH
- To develop and offer short courses on quantitative methods/environmental science/ climate change.
