- To develop research protocols, interpret research findings, generate high-quality publications, and disseminate results through appropriate media
- To prepare reports and present information to research groups, steering groups, etc. particularly progress reports, overseeing similar activities of research assistants when appropriate
- To identify sources of funding and lead the process of application

- To lead and develop internal and external networks, and collaborative groups, representing the University in a professional manner at all times, including links with professional bodies, research funding streams, etc.
- To mentor junior researchers' workshops and training on quantitative research methods
