Data Collector

The BRAC James P Grant School of Public Health (BRAC JPGSPH) at BRAC University was established in 2004 as an educational and research institution focusing on the integral areas of teaching, research, and services. The goal of the School is not only to impart knowledge but also to act as a Centre of excellence in knowledge creation through research and training that connects with practice. One of the projects of the school is ARISE (Accountability and Responsiveness in Informal Settlements for Equity) which address the intractable development challenge of ill-health, inequity, and insecurity in informal urban settlements in Low- and Middle-Income Countries in the context of complex and often dysfunctional governance arrangements. Under this project, we are going to conduct a survey. This survey will be undertaken with the most marginalized dwellers in informal urban settlements in Dhaka city, to support them in identifying their priorities, making their conditions visible to key service providers related to health (both government and non-government) across a range of sectors, and to work with identified allies amongst these actors to develop better mechanisms for accountability and more responsive services.

The study will recruit Data Collectors to collect survey data from the urban study sites. Details are stated below:

Job Responsibilities

- Collect data from field using ODK (Kobo toolbox) data collection software.
- Follow proper time schedule, have strong mentality to handle the situation raised in the field.
- Assist researchers in case of data processing.
- Ensure proper documentation of process of project works and the progress.

Requirement

- Bachelor's degree from any discipline with good academic records
- Minimum 2 year of working experience in data collection is required
- Prior experience of survey data collection in slum settlements
- Both male and female can apply
- Must have competence with the android-based app operation
- Good communication skill both in Bengali and English
- Willing to work in slum areas
