

## Training of Young People with Disabilities as Peer Researchers

**Date:** 1st September-3rd September,2021

**Number of Participants:** 20

**Description:** Youth with disabilities' lived experiences, aspirations, and current engagements in livelihoods in Bangladesh, and how they can share them with local decision-makers.

The training was organised by BRAC JPGSPH and Sightsavers. Conducted by Mrityika Barua (Assistant Professor) and Sayema Akter (Research Fellow) from BRAC JPGSPH along with Ayon Debnath and Syeda Asma Rashida (Country Directors) from Sightsavers. The purpose was to train 20 people with disabilities as peer researchers. The three days in-person training sessions took place in Gulshan's Lake Castle Hotel.
