



Workshop on the lessons learned from the “Synthesis and Translation of Research and Innovation in Polio Eradication” project

BRAC JPGSPH will implement the course in Bangladesh among program implementers of organizations such as Government, development partners, and local NGOs. Therefore, a half-day in-person curriculum workshop was organized by BRAC JPGSPH, BRAC University on Saturday, 23rd October 2021 at Hotel Amari Dhaka, Gulshan-2, Dhaka to make modules appropriate for Bangladesh context. The ultimate expectation was to develop a short course on how this learning can strengthen further the health system, disease surveillance, and the elimination of remaining vaccine-preventable diseases in Bangladesh. Twelve academicians and researchers from National Institute of Preventive and Social Medicine, Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Medical University, North South University, Bangladesh University of Health Sciences, World Health Organization, and icddr,b attended and took part in active discussion with BRAC, JPGSPH faculties. They suggested to include more examples from Bangladesh, and arrange a high level advocacy meeting for successful implementation of the course in Bangladesh.
